



Precedent of the Election Committee

Allegation 2122-04

Relevant Constitutional Sections:

Article XII, Section 4(a): All allegations of election misconduct are to be submitted to the Vice-President of Elections. All potential violations must be reported within 48 hours of the time committed or within one hour of the end of voting, whichever is sooner.

Relevant Facts:

The alleging party submitted an allegation without attaching evidence more than 48 hours since the alleged violation was committed.

Holdings:

1. The Election Committee has no jurisdiction over allegations of violations that took place more than 48 hours before the allegation.
 - a. This follows from the plain text of the above constitutional section.
2. The Election Committee may not hear allegations without the submission of evidence.
 - a. In this holding, the Judicial Council reaffirms Precedent 1920-04.
