

BYLAWS OF THE JUNIOR CLASS COUNCIL

Article I Purpose and Goals

1. The Junior Class Council exists and serves to unify the Class of 2024. The positive experience of any group relies on unity, and the Class Council works to promote camaraderie and amity for the Class of 2024.
2. The Junior Class Council Executive Board and Council members will fulfill its purpose by achieving the goals set forth below:
 - a. Create and facilitate opportunities and event programming for the Class of 2024 to interact and bond.
 - b. Serve as spiritual and community leaders for the Class of 2024.
 - c. Provide class-specific apparel to the Class of 2024.
 - d. Innovate and employ new practices to better the Class Council experience.
 - e. Work with other student leaders and University leaders to achieve the goals stated above.

Article II Executive Board

1. An Executive Board will be elected from among the Junior Class Council Dorm Representatives to run the Junior Class Council in accordance with the Constitution of the University of Notre Dame du Lac. The Executive Board will consist of one President, one Vice-President, one Treasurer, and one Secretary.
2. The Executive Board of Junior Class Council is responsible for correspondence among the Council and the entirety of the Class of 2024. They are responsible for timely and organized meetings and continued support for the council. The Executive Board shall attempt to make possible programming proposed by council members.
3. The Executive Board will maintain communication with the Junior Class Council SAO advisor to further the goals of the council.
4. The Executive Board of Junior Class Council will be available to any and all members so that the goals and events put forward by the council are effectively implemented.

Article III The Council

1. Members of the Junior Class Council must be members of the Class of 2024.
2. Members of the Junior Class Council shall be responsible for helping the Executive Board program events for the Class of 2024. As such, they shall be required to attend weekly meetings, propose new ideas, and help run events put

- on by the Junior Class Council.
3. The Council shall be subdivided into six (6) teams that will each be responsible for planning event programming and highlighting signature class events. The Executive Board will randomly assign teams to avoid biases on creating teams and allow all council members to get to know each other. The committees will be led by one (1) team leader. A team leader's responsibilities include, but are not limited to: overseeing their event team within our general assembly, involving themselves in the planning of their events while also delegating jobs to each team member, providing updates on their events, and bringing any questions their team may have to the Executive Board. The Executive Board will select a council member for each team leader position through an application process.
 4. Attendance at all Class Council meetings is required to maintain membership. Members of each team are required to attend and facilitate the programming put on by their own team. Council members are required to make the Secretary of the Executive Board aware through approved channels of communication if they will be unable to attend a meeting or event 24 hours before the meeting or event begins. Three total unapproved absences will result in Junior Class Council Members being suspended from the Council, unless there are extenuating circumstances. Arriving 10 minutes or more after the start of the meeting is considered tardy. Tardiness due to recurring academic commitments must be brought to the attention of the Executive Board. Tardiness is not considered absence, but two tardies without notice will result in a conversation between the Council member and the Executive Board regarding the respect of everyone's time. Approved reasons for tardiness and absences will be left to the discretion of the Executive Board.
 5. Any member of the Council may be suspended according to Section 3.4. The length of the suspension is subject to unanimous approval of the Executive Board. Any member of the Junior Class Council who is suspended will be notified as soon as the suspension is enacted. A formal suspension meeting shall be scheduled with the member and the full Executive Board.
 - a. A member may be reinstated with unanimous approval of the Executive Board.
 - b. A suspended member of Junior Class Council may be removed by unanimous vote of the Executive Board.
 6. If, at any time, a member of the Executive Board fails or is unable to fulfill the duties of their office enumerated in these Bylaws and in the Constitution, they may be recalled from office pursuant to Article XIV, Section 2 of the Student Union Constitution. In the event that an Executive Board member is recalled, an election will be held among the Council members within two academic weeks to fill the vacancy.

Article IV Meetings

1. The Executive Board shall schedule a meeting of the Council once a week during the academic school year from date of selection to the end of the term. This schedule may be altered with full agreement among the Executive Board.
2. Meeting structure shall be clearly outlined in an agenda to be presented to the council prior to the start of each meeting. Additionally, the Executive Board may alter the structure of meetings as they see fit to maximize the efficiency of the meetings and to promote the goals set herein.

Article V General Provisions on Bylaws

1. Amendments to the bylaws may be made with unanimous agreement of the Executive Board. Amendments may also be proposed and passed by a two-thirds vote of the Junior Class Council Membership. All amendments must be approved by the Student Activities advisor.
2. Junior Class Council shall be bound by these bylaws for the duration of their term.
3. These bylaws shall be reviewed following the election of the Junior Class Council. At this time, new bylaws shall be updated by the incoming Class Council members in consultation with the previous Class Council members before being submitted to the Student Union Ethics Committee for approval by October 1st.
